

Teaching the Rosary to Children

Begin teaching young children the Rosary with a Rosary ring.


Start by doing numbers 1, 2, & 5 below.

Once they have this down, continue to explain and add an element of prayer.

Take it slow. Within a few months they should understand the Mysteries, how to pray the Rosary, and what it means.

This is the full Guide:

- 1. Wear the Rosary Ring on either of your two index fingers.
- 2. Make the sign of the cross (if you wish, kiss the the crucifix).
- 3. Say the Apostles Creed, the Our Father, three Hail Marys and one Glory Be.
- 4. Announce the decade on which you are reflecting. For instance, the first joyful Mystery is The Annunciation of Gabriel to Mary.
- 5. Then recite the our Father prayer on the crucifix again and 10 Hail Marys on the 10 beads of the ring as your thumb turns the ring.
- 6. Complete the decade with the Glory Be and the O My Jesus prayer. Then repeat until you have prayed for a total of five decades for each Mystery.
- 7. Close your rosary ring prayers with Hail Holy Queen.



Note: Children love the glow-in-the-dark Rosary rings.! They can pray the rosary in bed at night with these.
